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UPCOMING ANNUAL MEETING & ELECTION



Your community Annual Meeting/Election is scheduled to be held on July 29, 2020. There are currently 5 positions up for election at this time. The 2 people receiving the highest amount of votes will serve a 2 year term, the next 3 people receiving the next highest amount of votes will serve a one year term. Orchard Glen must meet the quorum requirements for the Annual Meeting/Election to take place, which means there needs to be 40 ballot envelopes returned. If quorum is not met, the meeting cannot move forward.

Should quorum not be met and there is not a reconvened meeting scheduled, the current people will remain on the board for another year, unless they resign. Remember when returning your ballot the colored envelope must be completed in the upper left hand corner. If it is not completed it will not be counted. 

Hot Weather Tips:

- Drink plenty of water. Avoid alcohol and caffeine.

- Take a cool shower or bath.
